ABOUT THE FELLOWSHIP

Founded in 2002, Midwest Retina (MWR) has grown quickly into the largest retina-only private practice in Central Ohio. MWR is excited to offer a two-year comprehensive fellowship in vitreoretinal diseases and surgery beginning July, 2021 and ending July, 2023. After rotating with seven physicians that come from a variety of different training backgrounds, the fellow will have gained a broad experience and feel comfortable managing cases from the simple to the most complex. In addition, two physicians each have additional fellowship experience/interest in the treatment of uveitis and in the treatment of pediatric vitreoretinal conditions.

CLINICAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Rotations Fellow will rotate amongst faculty every 8 weeks
- Weekly At least two days full OR days with clinic on the remaining days
- Practice Call (Retina Only) q2 week call, fellows split the holidays; always attending back-up
- No fellow injection clinics
- Moonlighting Opportunity at Grant Hospital
- No travelling to satellite offices, only 4 main offices in Columbus Metro Area
